

Ekphrastic Poetry Workshop & Reading

Ekphrastic refers to a "conversation between two pieces of art". In this case the "conversation" will be between the photographic art of Sara Umemoto and your poetry.

Your work can take place before the workshop, or be crafted during the workshop. Either way, you will have a chance to discuss the construction of your poetry with Professor Robert Davidson (CSU, Chico) during the workshop. You will then have the opportunity to do a reading the following week at a "First Friday Art Night" Reception at the Red Bluff Art Gallery. Your poetry will also be eligible to appear in the magazine "RatBag" (published by the Gallery) and online at the Gallery website, RedBluffArtGallery.com. Additionally, the online e-zine Wordsandtricks.net will be publishing a special edition comprised of poetry from the Ekphrastic Workshop.
